ERITREA

According to Christian Solidarity Worldwide's submission to the United Nations UPR process in 2014, between 2,500 and 3,000 Protestants are detained indefinitely at any given time in Eritrea. Although some were initially released after pledging to renounce their faith, none have been formally charged or tried, and all are held pending similar denials of faith.

In May 2017, 122 Eritrean Christians were detained in a series of round-ups of members of unregistered denominations in various locations around the country. Fikadu Debesay, who was detained with her husband in May during raids targeting Evangelical Christians in Adi Ouala town, died in incarceration in early August.

On 5th March 2018, 10 friends were visiting a newly-wed couple in Asmara, when the police arrested them. The authorities released eight of the group two days later. The four remaining Christians, including the newlyweds, were moved to Adi Abeito Prison, north of Asmara. According the World Watch Monitor source, the newlywed couple was split up after the arrest and the bride was released on 27th March 2018

On 25th March 2018, Eritrean police arrested 32 Christians in the capital Asmara. Three days later all were still in detention.¹

Since Orthodox Patriarch Antonios was forcefully deposed in 2007, he has remained in incommunicado detention in an unknown location. Since then, he has only made one public appearance during a mass at St Mary's Cathedral in Asmara. He was surrounded by guards.

Twenty-three Orthodox priests are known to be still detained.

Jehovah's Witnesses, who were deprived of their citizenship after the ban of their movement in 1994, are also paying a heavy tribute with over fifty long-standing prisoners.

Date of release: June 2018

Other information: He is the senior pastor of the Kale Hiwot Church. He was arrested for participating in a Protestant wedding ceremony in Barentu. He was taken to Asmara Police Station No. 5, then subjected to ten months of solitary confinement and hard labour at Sawa military camp. He was released after six years, then re-arrested six months later, after a fleeing church member, who was being monitored, called him.
